TRAVEL TIPS

WHEN TO GO

The summer months between June and August are when Greece comes alive. Athens can tip the thermometer over the 30-degree mark, making the Mediterranean, Aegean and Ionian seas look so appealing. Follow the crowd and head to the coastal islands where the sultry daytime air is offset by cool, nightly sea breezes. A word of warning though – if you’re looking for a quiet holiday away from the crowds, this isn’t the season for you!

April to May and September to November are the most comfortable times to travel. Days are warm and less humid, nights are cool and there are fewer tourists. Sightseeing, especially walking through archaeological sites, is not too taxing during these months and you can capture the moment without capturing too many strangers in your photos!

Winter is generally very quiet with many hotels and attractions closing between December and February. Snow falls, although rare, are not unheard of in Athens.

THE GREEK ISLANDS IN WINTER

From October to April most of the Greek islands close down for tourism with the exception of Crete and Rhodes. The hotels and taverns in the main centres of Crete and Rhodes remain open while many of the resort hotels will close.

LANGUAGE

Greek is the official language of Greece. English is generally spoken in major cities and tourist areas.

VISAS & PASSPORTS

All travellers to Greece must carry a passport valid for at least six months beyond the date of departure from Australia. As visa information can change at any time, we recommend you seek advice regarding passports, visas and other travel requirements for the countries you intend visiting from the Australian Government at smartrtraveller.gov.au.

TIME

Greece is eight hours behind Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST). Daylight Saving Time is observed from March to October when the clocks are turned forward by 1 hour.

CURRENCY

Euro (EUR)

CITY TAX

A city tax applies in Greece. This amount is per room per night payable direct to your accommodation.

TIPPING & BARGAINING

Bargaining is acceptable and almost expected in markets in Greece. Tipping a few dollars per day for tour guides is expected. A 5-10% tip in restaurants is sufficient but check if the tip has already been included on your bill.

ELECTRICITY

230V 50Hz.

An international adapter is recommended.

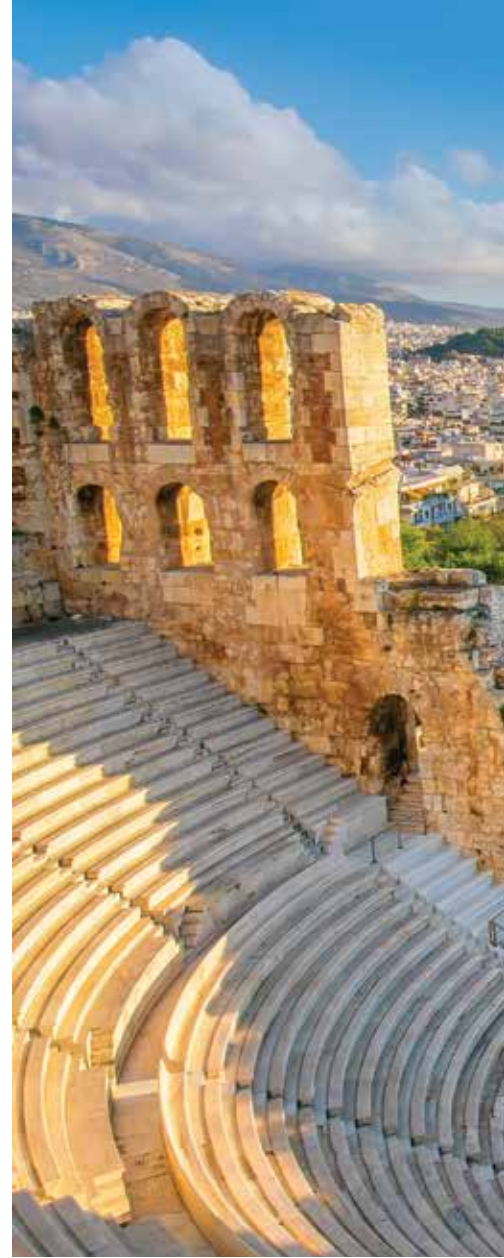

ATHENS

This vibrant capital is the heart of Greece, combining the old and new. Archaeological sites scattered throughout the city sit alongside brand new cultural centres and buildings. The ancient citadel, the Acropolis is positioned high above Athens and can be seen from every corner of the city. Visit the historic Panathenaic Stadium where the first modern Olympic Games were held. Wander the labyrinth of old streets of Plaka, visit treasure filled museums and soak up the atmosphere in a street café.

ANCIENT RUINS

Greece offers a host of ancient ruins and archaeological sites. Athens is home to the famous Parthenon, Temple of Zeus and Acropolis and it's almost impossible to walk through the city without discovering yet another archaeological site. The ancient Temple of Apollo at Delphi, the ruins at Olympia and the Temple of Poseidon on Cape Sounion are some of Greece's most widely recognised historical attractions. Many sites can also be found on the Greek islands of Delos, Crete and Mykonos.

ISLAND HOPPING IN GREECE

Greece's fabulous islands all offer a unique experience, from rest and relaxation to all night partying and many feature historical and archaeological sites. Accessing these islands is a breeze, with ferry services connecting many of the islands within their main group. Island groups include the Cyclades, Ionian and Dodecanese Islands, among others. Since almost all ferries conveniently depart from Piraeus, just outside of Athens, island hopping is a must for any Greek holiday itinerary.

HEAVENLY BEACHES

It's practically unheard of to visit Greece without including some serious beach time. The Aegean, Ionian and Mediterranean Seas provide the ideal flop and drop destinations with postcard scenery and warm, blue water. With its white cliffs and iconic shipwreck, Navagio Beach on Zakynthos is a popular place to bask in the sun. Balos Beach in Crete beckons with its brilliant white sandy beach and turquoise water.

UNESCO SITES

There is no shortage of UNESCO World Heritage Listed Sites in Greece which is home to 18 sites including the instantly recognisable Acropolis in Athens, the unspoiled Medieval City of Rhodes and the stunning natural landscapes of Meteora. The Old Town of Corfu includes three forts dating back to the 8th century BC and Thessaloniki's Paleo Christian and Byzantine Monuments are a fine example of early religious art.

ATHENS

Athens is the historical and cultural capital of Greece. Set high upon a hill, the rock of the Acropolis – featuring the ancient Parthenon – dominates the skyline and can be seen from almost every part of the city. Below the Acropolis lies the Plaka neighbourhood and the core of the historical centre. Here, discover a labyrinth of streets lined with shops, cafés, mosques and churches.
